

The Population Council seeks to deepen the knowledge base on Adolescent Transition to Adulthood in India through rigorous empirical and policy research. In this context, the Population Council, India aims to support researchers to write scientific papers on Adolescent Transition to Adulthood, using data from a unique longitudinal study of adolescents (UDAYA – Understanding the lives of adolescents and young adults) conducted by the Population Council in Bihar and Uttar Pradesh. The Council is currently inviting expression of interest from researchers to participate in the proposed scientific paper writing competition and conduct in-depth analysis of the UDAYA data (<https://www.projectudaya.in/wp-content/uploads/2017/03/Call-for-proposal.pdf>). The winners will be awarded prize money (\$2,000).
