After completing my M.Phil and Ph.D. in Population Studies from the International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS), I worked with several international organizations focusing on areas such as Maternal, Newborn, and Child Health (MNCH), Family Planning, Reproductive Health and Rights, Gender Equality, HIV/AIDS, Tuberculosis, Digital Health, Disaster Risk Reduction, and Renewable Energy.
