IASP Elections 2024

Guidelines for the Election Agency Regarding Scrutiny of Nominations

The final date for submitting nomination papers is 03 August 2024 by 6:00 PM. Scrutiny of the nominations will be conducted on 04 August 2024. During the scrutiny, ensure the following criteria are met:

1. Completeness of the Form:

The nomination form must be fully completed. Any missing information will result in rejection.

2. Post Applied For:

The post for which the nomination is made must be specified at the top of the form. Omitting this information will lead to rejection.

3. Candidate and Proposers Information:

All fields in the four boxes (candidate details, 'proposed by', 'seconded by 1', and 'seconded by 2') must be filled out. Proposer and seconders must be different members.

4. Name Verification:

Verify that the candidate's name matches the membership list available on the IASP website. Only the name is required to match; prefixes (e.g., Dr, Prof, Mr, Mrs) and initials do not need to be checked. Any discrepancies in the name will result in rejection.

5. Membership Number:

Verify the IASP membership number using the IASP website only. If the membership number is incorrect or missing, the nomination will be rejected.

6. Signature and Date:

Ensure that signatures and dates are present in all four required boxes. The absence of any signature or date will result in rejection.

7. Declaration Section:

- The name of the post must be entered in the Declaration section. Failure to include this will result in rejection.
- The candidate must sign at the end of the declaration. Missing signatures will lead to rejection.
- The date/place must be written at the end of the Declaration section. Missing information will result in rejection.

8. Number of Nominations

Multiple nominations can be submitted for a candidate for the same position and all valid nominations can be accepted

After scrutiny, the list of all valid nominations must be sent to all the candidates and placed on the website.
