Guidelines for Poster Presentations

POSTER PRESENTATION AND DISPLAY SCHEDULE

There will be two poster sessions, one held each day, on 16th February and 17th February. Posters will be available for viewing throughout the entire day. Presenting authors are responsible for setting up their posters at the start of each day and removing them at the end of the day.

Each poster board will be labelled with a unique poster number. You can find the specific number assigned to your poster presentation by referring to the final program (accessible from https://iasp.ac.in/media/2024/src_SCHEDULE_2024.pdf). We kindly request that authors be present by their respective posters during the designated poster presentation sessions, which will take place from 01:00 PM to 2:30 PM. This will provide an opportunity to engage with participants, discuss your research findings, and address any questions.

PRESENTATION PREPARATION

Poster Dimensions

Please ensure that the dimension of the poster should be **4 feet in height** and **3 feet in width**. All materials, including the title, author's name, and affiliation should stay within the confines of the poster size.

Guidelines:

- All posters should be based on the abstract that was submitted and subsequently accepted by the Scientific Program Committee.
- Each board will be identified with a unique number.
- Kindly bring your printed poster with you to the event. There will be no on-site printing facilities available.

Responsibility: Authors are responsible for the care and management of their own posters. Please be aware that the Organizing Committee will not assume responsibility for any damage to or loss of posters during the event.



Height 4 feet **Poster Design:** When designing your poster, prioritize readability and incorporate visual elements. Dedicate the top section of the poster for the title, authors' names, and affiliations. Remember that the audience may have limited time to peruse your poster.

Mounting and Supplies: Double-sided tape and other necessary mounting supplies will be provided on-site for your convenience. Avoid using foam core or any thick, multi-layered materials, and refrain from using pushpins directly on the poster boards. Ensure that the materials you use for your poster allow for easy and secure attachment to the boards.
