The President welcomed the members to the meeting

Item 1: Regional Conference of IASP

The North Eastern Regional Conference of IASP will be held during 18-19 May 2023 at Bodoland University. The President and the Organizing Coordinator, Dr Ajay Singh, briefed about the preparations for the conference. There will be three plenary sessions and eight technical sessions. Population Council, IASP and Bodoland University sponsor the plenary sessions. The Souvenir and abstract book are almost ready – some messages are to be inserted. Banners and hoardings are being prepared. The Treasurer informed the meeting that the conference material, including bags, will reach Bodoland University by 15th May. The adequacy of accommodation and the number of meals to be provided are to be verified with the local organiser. The conference programme also will be ready very soon. The President suggested publishing an edited volume of selected papers from the conference. President, Prof. Suresh Sharma has taken the charge of bringing out the edited book of selected papers

from the North Eastern Regional Conference of IASP. Dr Rajesh Chouhan is given the responsibility of bringing out the edited volume of the Udaipur Conference.

Item 2. Annual Conference 2023

The President informed the meeting that the next annual conference would be held during 8-10 November 2023 at NIT Rourkela, and Dr Jalandhar Pradhan would be the local organiser.

Item 3: Any other matter

Dr Anil informed that Dr Sabu Padmadas of the University of Southampton had agreed to deliver the Distinguished Lecture on 7th September. He also suggested sending an appreciation letter to Prof CR Rao, an eminent Statistician who recently got the International Prize in Statistics. Dr Anil also suggested organising a southern regional conference immediately after the annual conference.
