The Chair, Dr U V Somayajulu, welcomed and thanked all the members for joining the meeting. Agenda-wise discussion and decisions taken are given below.

1. Welcome address by President

Dr. Somayajulu gave a brief update on the major activities during the last five years (2017-2021) under his leadership. He briefed the members about crucial decisions taken, which improved the functioning and visibility of IASP. These included the development of integrated website of IASP and Demography India, online process for IASP membership, e-voting for IASP elections, increase in number of members, four in person annual conferences, two virtual annual conferences including the golden jubilee conference, regional conference at ISI Kolkata, skill development workshops for youth, webinars in collaboration with international academic institutes, digital publication of Demography India (the flagship journal of the IASP) etc. He also informed the members that one of the key achievements was organizing the International Population Conference (IPC) in collaboration with IUSSP. The conference was highly successful as it brought many laurels and visibility to the IASP on the global platform. He also informed the members that Rs5 lakhs taken from IASP to pay advance to the HICC has already been transferred to IASP. He further added that close to Rs45 lakhs was mobilised for the IPC 2021 by the NOC and thanked Population Council, IIPS, UNFPA, L4I, IHAT, ICRW, and PFI for their support to the NOC. Dr Somayajulu mentioned that close to Rs 12 lakhs that would be saved from the funds raised for the IPC would be transferred to IASP,

2. Confirmation of the minutes of the last joint meeting of EC and BOT

The President informed that the minutes of the joint meeting of BOT and EC held via the virtual platform on November 21, 2021 were circulated to all members. There were no specific suggestions or comments from the EC and BOT members. Prof Suresh Sharma proposed, and Dr Jeetendra Yadav seconded to approve the Minutes. The Minutes were approved in the meeting, and the same is attached herewith.

3. Admission of new members

There were a few new applications for life and annual membership of IASP. The present members approved the membership of four applications for life membership and two for the annual membership. New life members and annual members are given below.

4. IASP 2022 Election results

Dr. Somayajulu thanked Dr. CM Pandey and his team, Dr. RS Goyal, Dr. Sandip Anand, Dr. Audinarayana, Dr. Sanghmitra Acharya, Dr. M. Shivakami and Dr. Anup Kumar for successfully conducting the IASP Election 2022 online. The President also informed that 517 members participated in the election. Further, he stressed prioritizing an updated database of IASP Members to ensure improved participation of the members in IASP activities.

The President also informed that during the current election, the members elected President and ten executive committee members for the year 2022-2024. The two Board of Trustee (BOT) members were elected unopposed.
