National Seminar on Population Dynamics and Health Issues of Children in India

The Southern Chapter of IASP and Department of Demography, Kerala University, Thiruvananthapuram organized the National Seminar on **Population Dynamics and Health Issues of Children in India** at Kerala University, Thiruvananthapuram during April 23- 25, 2010. Thirty Second Annual Conference

Announcement 1: Thirty Second Annual Conference of IASP and Call for papers

The Thirty Second Annual Conference of IASP will be held at Utkal University, Bhubaneshwar during November 28-30, 2010. Dr G.K. Panda, Head, Geography Dept and Hon. Deputy Director, PRC, Bhubaneshwar will be the local organizing secretary. The main theme of the conference is "Population and Public Health".

The Millennium Development Goals to be achieved by 2015 relate to population and public health. The literature review indicates that India faces various public health challenges including infant and maternal mortality, life expectancy, literacy, social participation and empowerment, HIV/AIDS, Diabetes, health promotion including care and delivery, environmental health including food safety, vector control, water, sanitation and hygiene, air quality and trauma. There is a need to get insights into these issues and suggest policy and programme implications.

The conference would have plenary sessions and presentation of invited and contributed research papers and posters on the sub themes listed below:

- 1. Public Health Challenges in India;
- 2. Public Health Programmes in India and their impact;
- 3. Public health Communication;
- 4. Morbidities due to Communicable Diseases;
- 5. HIV/AIDS Control and Challenges;
- 6. Reproductive and Child Health;
- 7. Review of Status of NRHM;
- 8. Urbanization and Urban Health;
- 9. Tribal Health;
- 10. Population, Environment and Public Health.

The IASP members who have been actively involved in multi disciplinary research on population and public health are encouraged to share their thoughts, views and research findings on the sub themes listed above. The members are requested to contribute papers/posters on any of the sub themes. The paper/poster may identify gaps and/ or suggest ways and means to improve the programmes aimed at improving the public health in India. It could be a case study documenting best practices or based on primary or secondary data at district, state or national level or it might raise some of the methodological issues of significance. It could also be review of the existing policies and programmes. The paper must bring out the emerging issues in line with the main theme of the conference.

The modalities for submission of the papers and posters are broadly as follows:

- Prepare your abstract for paper/poster on one of the sub themes, as per the attached format. The abstract should be up to 250 words. The last date for submission is August 15, 2010. The abstract as word document and e mail attachment should be sent to the President/General Secretary of IASP on the Email ID: iasp.nims@gmail.com. PDF attachments will not be accepted.
- An expert committee will review and select the papers/posters to be presented at the conference
- The authors whose paper/poster get selected will be intimated by September 15,2010
- The complete paper including the abstract, tables/charts and annexure, if any, should not exceed 15 pages in 1.5 line spacing. The full papers of the selected abstracts should reach us latest by **October 30, 2010.**
- The selected authors should bring 30 copies of the paper for distribution during the conference.
- The volume of selected abstracts will be brought out and distributed during the conference.
- Due to paucity of funds, all authors of the selected papers are requested to try to manage for TA/DA from their parent institutions. IASP will try to mobilize fund to meet the travel expenses of those authors who are not able to manage their travel allowance (TA) from their institution and they apply well in advance to IASP to reimburse to a few selected authors for to and fro travel expenses by the shortest train route from their head quarters to Bhubaneshwar by AC-3 Tier. In case of such travel award, the train booking for both ways will have to be arranged by the awardees themselves. Please note that no claim will be entertained without photocopy of the tickets in support of TA. The members, whose papers are not selected or who have not submitted the paper, but wish to attend the conference, are welcome to do so at their own travel expenses. However, local hospitality will be provided to them.
- The members who desire to come with family will have to get all accompanying members registered in order that the food and stay expenses are to be borne by the association.

The decision to participate in the conference should be intimated latest by October 1, 2010.

Other details regarding the conference and stay arrangement will be communicated to the participants of the conference in due course.

Announcement 2: Dr. C. Chandrasekharan Award

Papers on the conference theme are invited from young members (below 30 years of age) for the Dr. Chandrasekharan award. The authors of papers selected by the Screening Committee would be invited for presentation during the Annual Conference. The eligible members are requested to send the abstracts by Aug 15, 2010 (through email as **word document** along with age proof) and full paper by September 1, 2010 to the General Secretary, IASP. The author of the selected paper would be intimated by September 15, 2010. The first and the second best papers will be presented with Dr. Chandrasekharan Award during the annual conference. The young scholars whose papers are selected will be reimbursed up to maximum AC-3 Tier sleeper train fare for their travel if requested in advance. Please note that the paper should not be of joint authorship.

Announcement 3: KB Pathak Memorial Award

The annual award in memory of Prof K B Pathak would be presented in the annual conference of IASP to the author of the best paper in the field of Population and Health with significant contribution in terms of methodological innovation. The papers must have been published in any refereed journal on Population/Demography and Health in the past two years. The author must be below 40 years of age. The papers along with age proof must be sent to the General Secretary of IASP before September 1, 2010.
